TO CAUSE YOU TO DOUBT YOUR IDENTITY IN GOD



Against Your Passion - Ephesians 6:10-20

He aims to diminish your desire for prayer, dull your interest in spiritual matters, and undermine the power of your most effective weapons.



Against Your Calling - Joshua 14:8

He amplifies fear, worry, and anxiety until they drown out all other voices, convincing you that following God is too risky an adventure to pursue.

Against Your Focus - 2 Corinthians 11:14

He disguises himself and distorts your perspective, causing you to focus on the wrong culprit and direct your weapons at the wrong enemy.



Against Your Purity - Isaiah 59:1-2

He attempts to lure you into specific sins, convincing you that you can indulge in them without facing consequences, all the while knowing they will create distance between you and God.





Against Your Identity - Ephesians 1:17-19

He magnifies your insecurities, causing you to doubt what God says about you and to overlook the gifts He has entrusted to you.



Against Your Rest & Contentment - Deuteronomy 5:15

He seeks to overwhelm your life and schedule, pressuring you to constantly push beyond your limits, never allowing you the freedom to say no.



He seeks to tear apart your family, sowing division, creating chaos, restlessness, and making it unfruitful.



Against Your Heart - Hebrews 12:15

He seizes every opportunity to keep old wounds fresh, knowing that anger, hurt, bitterness, and unforgiveness will only perpetuate the damage.





Against Your Confidence - Revelation 12:10

He relentlessly reminds you of your past mistakes and poor choices, attempting to convince you that you're under God's judgment rather than covered by His blood.



Against Your Relationships - 1 Timothy 2:8

He fosters disruption and disunity within your circle of friends and the shared community of the body of Christ.
